


Annual PREA Review for Corrective Action pursuant to PREA Standard 115.228  
 January 01, 2018 – December 31, 2018


The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) of 2003 mandates that correctional facilities, jails, and prisons provide a copy of their annual review (PREA Standard 115.288) of all related PREA investigations, determinations and corrective actions. This report is based on the Survey of Sexual Victimization for calendar year 2018. During calendar year 2018 the daily average population for the Female Community Corrections Facility was 129 residents with a maximum bed capacity of 137.

Generally speaking, PREA reports fall under four (4) classifications: 1. Inmate on inmate nonconsensual sexual harassment; 2. Inmate on inmate nonconsensual sexual misconduct/ abuse; 3. Staff on inmate sexual harassment; and 4. Staff on inmate sexual misconduct/ abuse. The following is a breakdown of the four individual PREA report classifications for calendar year 2018:

1. Number of resident on resident nonconsensual sexual harassment PREA reports: 4  
 Determination: Substantiated-1; Unsubstantiated-1; Unfounded-0  
 Corrective action: Referred to Law Enforcement-0; Administrative-1
2. Number of resident on resident nonconsensual sexual misconduct/ abuse PREA reports: 2  
 Determination: Substantiated-0; Unsubstantiated-2; Unfounded-0  
 Corrective action: Referred to Law Enforcement-0; Administrative-2
3. Number of staff on resident sexual harassment PREA reports: 2  
 Determination: Substantiated-0; Unsubstantiated-2; Unfounded-0  
 Corrective action: Referred to Law Enforcement-0; Administrative-0
4. Number of staff on resident sexual misconduct/ abuse PREA reports: 0  
 Determination: Substantiated-0; Unsubstantiated-0; Unfounded-0  
 Corrective action: Referred to Law Enforcement-0; Administrative-0
